Construction worker accidents and third-party claims

Although injured workers are prohibited from suing their employers for workplace injuries because of workers' compensation benefits laws, they still may file for a personal injury lawsuit against third parties - such as property owners, subcontractors and their insurance companies - who were responsible for their injury. This is called a "third-party cause of action." If someone other than the employer was fully or partially responsible for the cause of your personal injury or that of your family member or loved one, you or they may be able to sue that third party with one of our construction accident attorneys and still file your workers' compensation benefits claim.
