Motorcycle transportation risks

Motorcycles are a popular form of transportation for Americans, with 8.32 million registered in the United States, over 280,000 of them in Illinois alone. Despite the motorcycle's prevalence on the road and their status as part of Americana, motorcycle drivers are often at higher risk of injuries or fatalities than their fellow drivers of light trucks or passenger vehicles. The consequences of motorcycle accidents can be devastating, leading to property damage, serious injuries and even wrongful death of you or a loved one.

Motorcycle riders are 10 times as likely to be killed in a fatal accident than occupants of light trucks and six times as likely as passenger vehicles. When adjusted for every 100,000 miles traveled, motorcycle occupants are almost 43 times as likely to be killed in accidents than occupants of light trucks and 28 times more likely than passengers in cars. Overall, motorcycles are 29 times more likely than other forms of consumer transportation to suffer serious injuries or worse in motor vehicle accidents. Road rash, head injuries, spinal cord injuries, fatal injuries and more are all found at accident scenes by police officers. Motorcycle safety by motorists and motorcyclists is paramount to avoid ending up on a police report or needing medical care or medical attention, for all parties involved in daily transportation.

Insurance companies and motorcycle accidents

Insurance companies play significant roles in working on the prevention of motorcycle crashes and the post-accident recovery process for injury cases. According to statistics reviewed by insurance companies, the rates for motorcyclists are affected by the potential of personal injury, typically serious injuries and sometimes fatalities. Wearing a helmet not only helps prevent head injuries but also contributes to bringing down the cost of insurance for motorcyclists.

In injury cases arising out of traffic accidents or car accidents, motorcyclists will have property damage and medical bills from medical care from seeking medical attention that may cause them serious economic harm.
