In most cases, the types of damages do not depend on the cause of the wrongful death. Most often, they depend on the financial loss that the death caused. - Punitive damages
- Non-economic damages
- Funeral expenses
- Loss of future inheritance
- Loss of parental guidance if the decedent has children who are minors
- Loss of spousal companionship
- Loss of the decedent's benefits

- Loss of the decedent's future income
- Medical bills
- Pain and suffering of the decedent their death
- Pain, suffering, grief and sorrow of the survivors from losing a loved one
- Punitive damages if the defendant's actions were deliberate or hateful
